What is Relay For Life?

Relay For Life is the American Cancer Society's signature 24 hour team event. It offers everyone in the community a chance to participate in the fight against cancer. This is the 7th year of Relay For Life of Westfield.

Because Relay For Life is a Community event versus an athletic event, anyone and everyone can participate.

Teams form from businesses, clubs, families, friends, hospitals, churches, schools and service organizations. Team members share a common purpose - to support the American Cancer Society's mission to raise awareness and funding to fight cancer, including much needed funds for research, education, advocacy, prevention and patient services.

At Relay, there is peace of mind knowing that together we can face the challenges ahead.



Why Relay?

Relay For Life offers the community an opportunity to join together to increase efforts for awareness and prevention of cancer while raising money for research to fight cancer.

For the newly diagnosed and patients in treatment, Relay offers a chance to meet someone who has survived the same type of cancer.

Relay also provides an opportunity to share with others and learn about ways to cope with cancer via nutritional means and other aspects at the Health Fair.

Relay also provides time to grieve for those lost to cancer and to celebrate the lives of those who have survived.

For the long-term survivor, Relay brings a community's recognition of the struggle and closure to a trying time in life.

Caregivers also find hope in Relay For Life. These individuals give their time, love and support to family, friends, and neighbors who face cancer.

What is Expected of Me When I Join?

Once you or your group join our team you can sign up in a time slot to take turns walking at the Westfield Washington School District Track. Because cancer never sleeps, we sign walkers up to cover all 24 hours of this overnight event.

The goal is to raise \$100 per team member. Dollars raised for Relay For Life are used to help in the fight against cancer.

Raising funds is easy. Ask your friends, family, co-workers, neighbors, etc. to help you fight cancer by making a donation or purchasing a luminaria.

Your employer may even offer matching gifts for the money you raise for the American Cancer Society. Check with your human resources department.

But most of all, we want you to have fun and know that with every step you take, you help the American Cancer Society save lives.
